Details: On today's date, SA contacted Peter Schlossman, Trial Attorney, DOJ, concerning the upcoming civil trial in Trentadue v. U.S.. Schlossman indicated that the trial had been continued from October 12, 1999 until November 8, 1999.

According to Schlossman, at the conclusion of a hearing last week, plaintiff's counsel asked him if he had wired an inmate during a meeting with Baker. During that same hearing, plaintiff's counsel advised the judge that they believed Schlossman was intimidating potential witnesses at the Florence FCI. Schlossman denied both charges without revealing the existence of this investigation. Schlossman believes that the plaintiff's still intend to call Alden Gillis Baker as a witness



Due to plaintiff's increased suspicion, and the importance of the civil case, no further attempts to approach Baker will be made until after the conclusion of the aforementioned trial.
